Pilot: Aalto Thesis Program

Aalto Thesis is a project-based and multidisciplinary program for making the master's thesis in work-life collaboration. In one Aalto Thesis project, 2-4 students from different Aalto schools are working on their own master's theses around a topic provided by the partner organization.

Why studies delay?

- 1. Working
- 2. Course timing
- 3. Lack of motivation
- 4. Family reasons
- 5. Lack of guidance

6. Thesis

(Opiskelijabarometri 2014; Liimatainen et al. 2010)

- Challenges in time management decreases abilities to study (Liimatainen et al. 2010)
- Poor work-life connections in studies weakens motivation (Liimatainen et al. 2010)
- Support from peers enhances studies "in great amount" for 55-60 % of students (Saari 2013)



Improving thesis process

Focus on group guidance and peer support

(Stenlund 2010; Liimatainen et al. 2010)

Aalto Thesis Program offers project and time management practice, work-life connections, and peer support which were lacking in studies

Master's Thesis practices in Aalto

- Seminars often include writing research/thesis plan, presenting the plan, reviewing other's texts, presenting finished thesis
 - Some differences between schools and programs!

- All theses are 30 cr and include a presentation and a maturity essay
 - Presentation dates from 4 times a year (ARTS, ENG) to all year round
 - Common guideline (especially ELEC, CHEM, ENG & SCI) to write thesis on <u>2. year spring semester</u>
- → For Aalto Thesis Program the timing is essential: the most optimal time for writing the thesis is 2. year spring semester!

2020
